this book first published in 1987 studies the forces promoting underdevelopment in

china prior to 1949 and the character of the development that has occurred since then it presents a unified perspective for grasping the development process as a whole for relating this to the class structure of china and for considering development in the context of chinese efforts to carry out a transition to socialism

this collection of essays written from 1947 1986 by fei hsiao tung china s most distinguished sociologist and anthropologist presents a rich and representative sampling of the research that has characterized his long career in 1936 fei conducted field work in kaixian gong a village in jiangsu province in east china this village became the subject of his now classic study peasant life in china in which he argued that because of china s huge population and the scarcity of cultivable land household industries such as production of raw silk were vital to the peasants economic survival his conclusions long rejected by china s policymakers have recently been embraced by the government under the political leadership of deng xiaopeng returning to kaixian gong in 1957 and again in the 1980s fei examined the changes that had occurred since his initial research three essays that resulted from these follow up studies are included in this collection providing a rare summary and analysis of developments in the village between 1936 and 1986 also included here are four articles based on fei s 1983 84 research in other areas of jiangsu province his explorations of the contrast between the wealth of southern jiangsu and the long standing poverty of the northern half of the province address key issues of public policy in china today useful to students of rural sociology as well as of chinese history politics economics and anthropology this collection will provide an overview not only of developments in the small towns of china but also of fei s thought

not least the class struggle between capital and labor can be avoided thus the root of war will be forever exterminated so far as china is concerned each part of the different programs in this international scheme is but a rough sketch or a general policy produced from a layman's thought with very limited materials at his disposal so alterations and changes will have to be made after scientific investigation and detailed survey for instance in regard to the projected great northern port which is to be situated between the mouths of the tsingho and the Iwanho the writer thought that the entrance of the harbor should be at the eastern side of the port but from actual survey by technical engineers it is found that the entrance of the harbor should be at the western side of the port instead so i crave great indulgence on the part of experts and specialists

the regional differences in economic growth and the regional disparity one reason could be the preferential policies in the eastern regions these policies are specially prepared to attract foreign companies a second reason that is current discuss in the scientific world could be the geographical characteristics the differences in the distance to the coast or navigable river the climate or the slope could explain variable development this paper wants to illuminate especially the second reason as a possible answer for unequal regional development and regional disparity but policy and geography are often the same so it is important to show the link between these possible reasons and the policies with regional impacts there are different publications about the geographical implication on economic growth in china in the last years based on different models the intention is to compare these papers and highlight the differences the first chapter handles the historical economic development of the last years in china and wants to show the actual situation the development especially in policy terms the change to a market orientated economy could already explain many disparities the third chapter illuminate the regional inequality in china there development the theories of convergence and want to give a first answer for the different growth rates then we will look to the geography and their effects to chinese growth rates and at least we make an outlook on future development base on polarization theory

To study the major domestic issues and the global implications of this program, the University of Victoria's Centre for Asia Pacific Initiatives organized and hosted a multidisciplinary international conference on March 6-8, 2003. This volume of papers presented at the conference offers perspectives on the issues by leading experts of diversified academic disciplines from China, Canada, the US and other countries.
