production of life with father and at once he offered her a long contract she was the only actress to be nominated for an academy award for her first three pictures the little foxes the pride of the yankees and mrs miniver and she won for the third film movie fans and scholars to this day admire her performance in the classics shadow of a doubt and the best years of our lives the circumstances of her tenure at goldwyn and the drama of her breaking that contract forever changed the treatment of stars wright's family and heirs appointed spoto as her authorized biographer and offered him exclusive access to her letters and papers major supporting players in this story include robert anderson alfred hitchcock william wyler karl malden elia kazan jean simmons dorothy mcguire bette davis george cukor marlon brando george c scott the artist al hirschfeld stella adler and more
